What are the origins of the word "ecology"?

Ecology comes from the Greek words "**Oikos**," meaning house, and "**logos**," which refers to science and knowledge. It is the study of the relations between **living organisms** and their interactions with each other and the places they live. Since the 20th Century, the term is also used in reference to actions that aim to protect the environment.
